It is possible to write the paper in Serbian, English or Russian languages only (Times New Roman –TNR 10 pt normal).

All owed text editors: MS Word 2000 or higher.

The length of the paper is limited to 5 (five) pages.

For the paper to be published it is necessary to send: by e-mail: lemima@fbsp.edu.rs.

Dead line for full paper submission is 10 March 2017.

2.1. Format

Preferably use A4 (297x210mm) page (by ISO216 and ISO478) format with margins(mm): 25top, bottom, left and right.

2.2. Tables

Each table is numbered and table captions are in TNR 10 pt, placed above the table, centered and have the following style.

2.3. Figures

Figures should be numbered. Please do not insert figures into text boxes. Figure caption is in TNR 10 pt, placed below the figure, centered and has the following style:



2.4. Equations

- For a book: author(s), (year). book title (*italic*), page or chapter numbers, publisher, city. (Lynch, N. A. (1996) *Distributed Algorithms*, Morgan Kaufmann Publisher, San Francisco.)
- For a journal paper: author(s), (year). paper title, journal name (*italic*), volume and issue numbers, page numbers (inclusive). (Miryala, K. and Harandi, M. T. (1991) Automatic derivation of formal software specifications from informal descriptions, *IEEE Transactions on Software Engineering*, Vol. 17, no.2, pp. 1126-1142.)
- For a proceedings paper or chapter in an edited book: author(s), (year). paper or chapter title, volume title (*italic*), editor(s), volume number (if applicable), publisher, city, page numbers (inclusive)
- For a Web article: author(s), (year). article title, Web site name, URL.

Use the style specification as:

- Title of Reference: Times New Roman –TNR 12 pt
- Reference: Times New Roman –TNR 10 pt
